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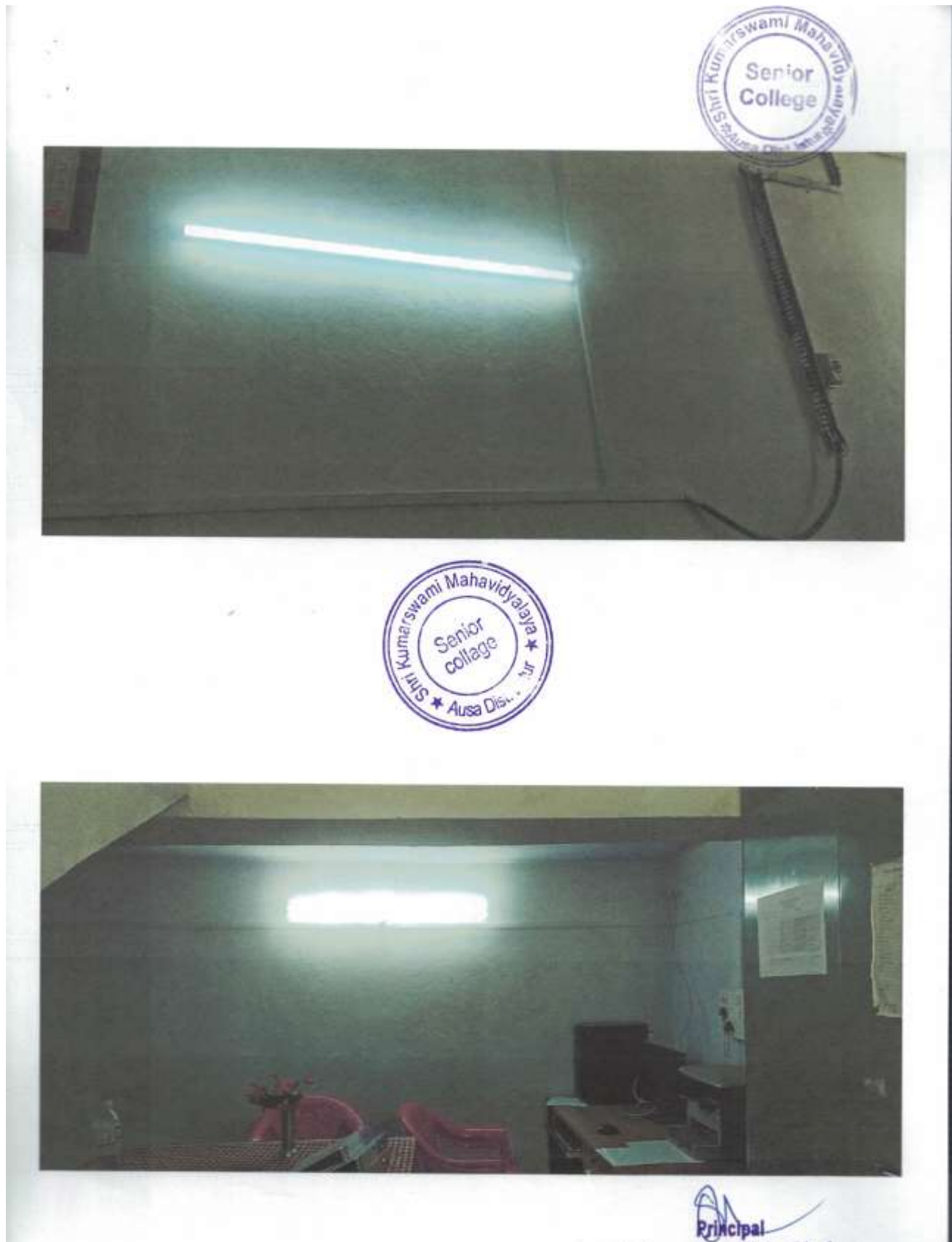
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Green Campus initiatives

Green policy of institution or clean and green campus policy

Our college shri Kumar swami Mahavidyalaya, Ausa is a quality conscious college. It protects environment with its green campus initiatives and maintains a pollution free green and clean campus.

The students are given strict instructions to maintain the campus clean and green.

Waste management: -

Institute encourages environment friendly practices as follows-

Solid waste management: -

- To reduce waste at institute, students and staff are educated on paper waste management practices through lectures, advertisement on notice boards, displaying slogan boards in the campus.
- Waste is collected on a daily basis from various sources and is separated as dry and wet waste.
- Colour coded dustbins are used for different types of wastes green for wet and blue for solid waste.
- Daily garbage is collected and saved in pit for composting process.
- Efforts have been taken to produce compost manure from the solid wastes and wastes from other sources. Manure is used for the purpose of herbal garden as well or for the planted tree.

Liquid Management: -

- The waste chemicals mixed waster from laboratory passes through concealed pipe line into soak pit.

E-Waste Management-

- The E-waste collected is stored in store room and disposed every year accordingly.
- The buyback system is followed for pharmacology rotating drums beyond repairable conditions. Empty toners, cartridges, outdated computers and electronic items are sold as scarp to ensure their safe recycling.
- Old monitors and CPUs are repaired by our technician and reused.

1. Rain Water Harvesting:

Water is elixir of life. According to the quotes " harvest the rain, reap the gains" , " savethe water of rain and don't let into drain", the college has taken steps to save rain water especially Maharashtra depend on rain water for its agriculture and drinking water. Unfortunately, during heavy rains most of the water is being wasted into drainage. Hence rain water harvesting is considered as a major aspect of the college. The collected rain water from roof tops, surface runoff water as percolated in ground level.

2. Tank and bunds:

As a part of revival to traditional wisdom, the institutional built rain water storage tank to collect the rain water and can be used whenever it is required.

Bunds are made to control the water table within the reclamation area and control the flow of discharge water in the filled area.

3. Borewell:

the borewells on campus are used to replenish rain water. Borewell recharge technique also make sure the storage of naturally filtered rain water.

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4. Waste water recycling:

The waste water after treatment is proposed to be utilised effectively for gardening and washing purposes.

5. Maintenance of water bodies and distribution system in the campus:

Water works departments maintain the water bodies and distribution system in the campus. There are few numbers of overhead storage tanks. The water is distributed through well laid pipe network.

7.1.5 Green campus initiatives :-

Green campus initiative includes

1. Restricted entry of automobiles.
2. Use of bicycles / battery power vehicles.
3. Pedestrian friendly Pathways.
4. Ban on use of plastic.
5. Landscaping with tree and plants.

1. Restricted entry of automobiles:-

College does not allowed to entry in the campus premises all the vehicles.

In the college campus restricted automobiles can enter and most of them park in the parking area.

Students are strongly advised to use public transport/ Bicycles for commuting to college to promote the Green initiatives of the college.

They are informed that the idea of making use of public transport wherever possible, reduce pollution and sustain a green planted.

Vehicles speeds shall be limited to 10 km/hr inside the campus.

2. Use of Bicycles:

The students are using bicycles. The students and staff coming from nearby villages also prefer bicycle as a mode of transport for attending the college. It is environment friendly and prevent pollution.

3. Pedestrian Pathway:-

Vehicle parking space is provided at the main entrance of the college campus. As the campus is vehicle free with the some exceptions, students and staff experience comfort Walking Through The pedestrian friendly pathway. The internal Road are lined with tree. They are properly maintained by the campus maintenance kamin committee.

4. Ban on plastic use.

Single used plastic items such as plastic bags, bottles, spoons, cups, straws are banned completely and awareness is created among staff and students through display boards in the premises.

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The staff and students are informed to use steel or copper water bottle instead of plastic bottles.

5. Landscaping with trees and plants:

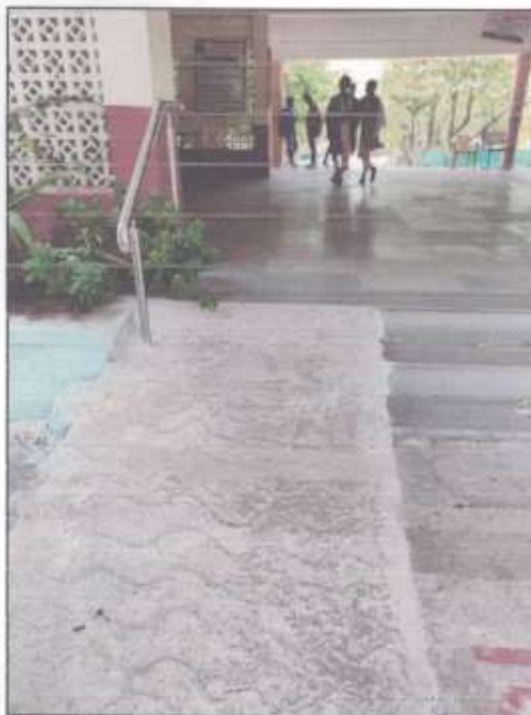
Every year during rainy season college takes the initiative of plantation inside the college campus.

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Ramp for disabled persons

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
